



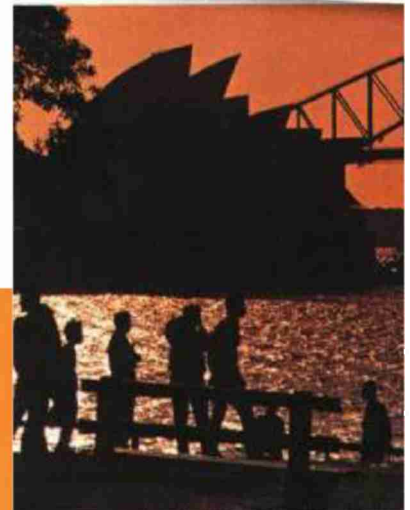
Feel the balmy breeze while sipping the locals' best or kick up your heels in a city that never sleeps.
